Reminders to all Members

A reminder to members to check your bisque ware and glaze your work or take your work home until you are ready for glazing. The shelves in the storeroom are full and the work needs to be glazed as storage space is limited. Remember to collect finished glazed work from the shelves in the library/office area.

There should be no double dipping of glazes unless you check with the technician or unless you are absolutely certain the glaze will not run.

All members need to make sure that the glazes they use are stoneware glazes.

No earthenware clay/glazes are to be used. Members that use the wrong clay/glazes and hence shelves are damaged will be liable for the replacement cost of the damage caused to the kiln stilts and shelves.

Members please note that when classes are in session during Term 4 you are not permitted to enter the studio to do your own work. If members are using the studio prior to the commencement of a class all members need to leave the studio 1 hour prior to the class commencing.

A reminder that on the website there is a timetable of classes that run on a weekly basis and when the studio is available for use by the members.

Wednesday, Friday and Sunday are club days and all members are welcome to use the studio on these days.

In the library there are a range of resources that can be borrowed. Members are asked to complete the register in the red file and return books within a two week period. Thankyou to Tracey Lee Van Den-Bergh for organising the resources for members to borrow.

There are limited moulds in the studio. Members are asked not to take the moulds home. They are only for use within the studio.
