## **RECYCLED CLAY**

Tracey-Lee, Cezarne and numerous helpers continue the onerous work of recycling clay for all members to use. The clay is located in a plastic bin near the pug mill in the studio and is available for purchase for \$3 a bag. An honesty system is being used for payments - just fill in one of the forms and drop it into the firing payments box in the glaze room so that it can be charged to your firing account. Make a note of the bag number in the recycled clay log.

#### MEMBERS-ONLY WORKSHOPS

Everyone is reminded that it is the responsibility of all users of the Karlup Ceramics Studio to clean all areas thoroughly after you have finished working. This includes tabletops, floor and chairs.

When using the plaster slabs for drying clay, please remember to clean them thoroughly and leave them in the glaze room to dry, not in the studio.
