Guidelines for website submission:

- You will have your own page in the Members'
 Gallery section of the website. This means that
 you can circulate the web address of this page
 as your personal web page if you wish. eg:
 https://sorpottersclub.com/members-gallery/your-name
- Include a paragraph or two of information about yourself and your work. Feel free to include links to your website or Facebook page or an email address. (Check the website to see what others have written.)
- Preferably include at least one photo that clearly shows your face, preferably at work on a pot.
- The pictures will have square format when posted keep that in mind when composing your photos.
- File size up to about 500Mb. The photos of your work should clear and well lit.
- Photos are displayed in rows of three, so it is suggested that you submit multiples of three eg. 6, 9, to a maximum of 12
